NEET PG 2023 Syllabus is prepared by NBE. NEET PG Shall be a multiple Choice questions exam on the Computer-Based Platform (CBT). The Examination comprises of 300 Multiple Choice, Single correct response questions in English Language only. Time will be allotted for 3 Hrs & 30 Mins. The NEET PG Syllabus comprises subject areas as per the Graduate Medical Education Regulations issued by Medical Council of India.

NEET-PG 2023 Shall be conducted in a Single Day & Single Session as a Computer-Based Test on **05 March, 2023**.
